REGULATORY SIGNS - HEAVY VEHICLE

Policy: These signs must be erected by the road controlling authority to advise HMV operators of all restrictions on the use of heavy motor vehicles imposed under appropriate legislation on its roads. No other sign may be attached to either the sign or its support.

Location: The sign should be erected on the left hand side of the road normally about 15 m before the start of the restriction and repeated as necessary in advance of, or along the restricted road. Each sign should be located so that an approaching driver has an uninterrupted view of it over a distance of at least 60 m. Advance warning versions of the signs should be erected at carefully chosen locations which will ensure that HMV operators are not unduly inconvenienced should they need to choose an alternative route.
